## Pick-up Points:

### Obverse markers

- DDO "B" example of the otherwise impressive 1971S SB DDO Family 1. There is tripling in the motto, characterized by a heavier notching just north of a lesser notching. The D in GOD is most characteristic of this pattern. There is no vertical split in the W of WE (which is a characteristic of 1971S SB DDO Family 3). Also characteristic of 1971S SB DDO Family 1 is notching in the lower left portion of the foot of the R in LIBERTY, and hair strand doubling.
- Loss of the course die abrasion work from 1SB-310.1, leaving a few key remnant dies scratches. The hallmark scratch is the oblique scratch inside the L of "LIBERTY".
- The UDU clash remnant is now lost due to further die work, and there is still no talon head evidence or volunteer clash
- Under the chin, a faint die crack begins to emerge during this production stage.
- Mild further loss of pupil (approximately lower  $\frac{1}{2}$ ), with loss of coarse abrasions in front of the pupil seen in 1SB-310.1

### Reverse markers

- This is a new reverse die marriage versus 1SB-310.1
- DDR - a "C" example of the 1971S SB DDR Family 1. The is vertical notching present in ends of the LL in DOLLAR, notching in the lower end of the C in AMERICA, and doubling seen in stars 10 through 13. The spread is not nearly as robust as "A" examples of 1971S SB DDR Family 1.
- Die scratches associated with NE in "ONE" and LA in "DOLLAR".
