Pick-up Points:

Obverse markers

- DDO "B" example of the otherwise impressive 1971S SB DDO Family 1. There is tripling in the motto, characterized by a heavier notching just north of a lesser notching. The D in GOD is most characteristic of this pattern. There is no vertical split in the W of WE (which is a characteristic of 1971S SB DDO Family 3). Also characteristic of 1971S SB DDO Family 1 is notching in the lower left portion of the foot of the R in LIBERTY, and hair strand doubling.
- The hallmark die scratch inside the L in LIBERTY remains unchanged from 1SB-310.1 & 1SB.310.2
- Fine die abrasion present in the talon head clash area - evidence of a preceding talon head clash (untouched in 1SB-310.2 and earlier)
- A residual Volunteer clash is apparent
- Distinct field bending adjacent to Ike's head and chin/neck area
- The die scratches below the foot of the R in Liberty are lost (compared to 1SB-310.2) due to further die work, and the foot of the R has moved closer to peg leg status. The die scratches above the foot of the R that are present in 1SB-301.2 remain intact.
- Die scratch below the E in WE
- Die crack under the chin is apparent
- Still further loss of pupil (approximately lower $\frac{3}{4}$)

Reverse markers

- Reverse die marriage differing from 1SB-310.1 & 1SB-310.2
- DDR - a "B" example of 1971S SB DDR Family 3. The spread in minor and barely seen in AR of DOLLAR and star 13.
- Die scratches associated with ONE and LL and the crater above it.
