Pick-up Points:

Obverse markers

- DDO - “b” example of the 1971S DDO Family 2. 1971S DDO Family 2 typically has doubling and tripling in the motto, best seen in D. This example is a “b” specimen, meaning the normally small spread tripling is washed out / less apparent than an “a” example.
 - Typical of 1971S DDO Family 2, there is no notching in the foot of the R in LIBERTY (lower left in Family 1, and lower right in Family 3), nor does it have hair strand doubling (as do Families 1 and 3).
 - There is no split W in WE (that would be 1971S SB DDO Family 3)
- MMP - different from the 1SB-310.1/.2/.3 obverse die
- Die scratch associated with the upper left of the L in LIBERTY
- Full pupil

Reverse markers

- The DDR is an “A” example of the 1971S SB DDR Family 2. Doubling can be seen in the rim devices and stars. Pick-up notching can be seen in the E in ONE, T in UNITED, and S in STATES. As with “A” examples of this DDR family, micro island doubling can be seen.
 - Comparison: The WDDR-021 of “4/21” and 1SB-301 notoriety is a super-“A” member of the 1971S SB DDR Family 2, bearing “doubling of doubling” - likely a true DDR.
- The “22” has die scratch markers that include:
 - Die scratch between the earth and the eagle’s right wing
 - Die scratches from the U in UNUM down to the earth and to the eagle's head
 - Die scratches associated with multiple letters in UNITED
