Pick-up Points:

Obverse markers

- DDO - “c” example of the 1971S DDO Family 2. 1971S DDO Family 2 typically has doubling and tripling in the motto, best seen in D. This example is a “c” specimen, meaning the normally small spread tripling is quite washed out / less apparent than an “a” example; only the R and U notching can be easily identified.
 - Typical of 1971S DDO Family 2, there is no notching in the foot of the R in LIBERTY (lower left in Family 1, and lower right in Family 3), nor does it have hair strand doubling (as do Families 1 and 3).
 - There is no split W in WE (that would be 1971S SB DDO Family 3)
- MMP - different from both, the obverse die of 1SB-310.4 and the obverse die of 1SB-310.5
- Die abrasion Peg Leg R in LIBERTY
- Grade C abraded talon head clash
 - No Volunteer clash
- NTR die crack through the motto
- Incomplete pupil
- Key die scratches:
 - Adjacent to the R in LIBERTY
 - Associated with the U and between OR in the motto
 - No key scratches associated with the L in LIBERTY

Reverse markers

- The same “22” reverse as in 1SB-310.4, except that the die state appears to be slightly earlier - VEDS
 - DDR - the “22” reverse previously described and depicted
 - Die scratches - previously described and depicted with the “22” reverse
