Pick-up Points:

Obverse markers

- DDO - 1971S SB DDO Family 1 (MMP3). Prominent doubling in IGWT (without vertical split W notching). Also present in LIBERTY, wherein, the most important marker for this DDO Family 1 is the notching on the lower left foot of the R. Hair doubling and pupil doubling present. (Note: this DDO is of an identical pattern found in the entire 1971S SB DDO Family 1, which includes Wexler WDDO-006, Wexler WDDO-007, Wiles/CONECA WDDO-004, NGC VP-007)
- Die crack in the Y of LIBERTY
- MMP

Reverse Markers

- Characteristic die gouge in the left wing of the Eagle, hence "Wounded Wing" (a remotely possible alternative source would be hubbed through debris)
- DDR - 1971S SB DDR Family 2. Small spread doubling seen best in this example in stars 8, 9, 10. Also notching in areas typical of 1971S SB DDR Family 2 - E in ONE, T in UNITED, and 1st S in STATES - although mushy examples of each.
- Oblique die scratch associated with the 1st L in DOLLAR
- Short, fine die scratches near star 9 and the S in PLURIBUS
